1. St Luke's Grammar School awards Academic Scholarships to students in Years 7, 10 and 11.
2. The Years 7 and 11 Scholarships are available to both current St Luke's students and those not currently enrolled.
3. The Year 10 Scholarship is only available to students not currently enrolled at St Luke's.
4. The awarding of the Academic Scholarships will be based upon performance in the Allwell testing
5. Based on the results of the tests, a percentage of applicants will be called in for Interview
6. Applicants selected for Interview will be required to send additional documentation, including:
 - NAPLAN Results
 - UNSW ICAS Certificate Awards ie High Distinction in Mathematics, Distinction in Science etc
 - Summary of Extra Curricular Achievements in Music, Sport, Performing Arts or Drama
 - Other relevant information that gives insight to the applicant's interests and achievements
7. The Principal in consultation with the Deputy Teaching & Learning will determine the Scholarship(s) to be offered.
8. The Academic Scholarships will be offered as either 100%, 50% or 25% of School Fees (Not including Acceptance Fees, Entrance Fees or Service Charges) depending upon the number of students identified for receiving a Scholarship.
9. All Academic Scholarship recipients will be placed in the Headland Program for Gifted and Talented students.
10. Academic Scholarship recipients will have their progress reviewed each year.
