



NAPLAN RESULTS 2009

Years 3 & 5

This year NAPLAN results for Years 3 and 5 are particularly impressive and highlight the work not only of the staff on these grades, but every class and specialist teacher in the Junior School. As is clearly evident by the following results St Luke's students have performed considerably higher than the State average. Furthermore, trend data shows growth in both literacy and numeracy for both Years 3 and 5 over time which is especially pleasing.

In the following tables comparing St Luke's results to the State, Band 6 for Year 3 and Band 8 for Year 5 are the highest bands. The State average appears in brackets.
