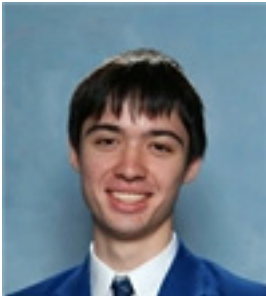


## HSC RESULTS

### The 2011 Year 12 again achieved excellent results in the Higher School Certificate.

The 2011 HSC results are pleasing overall. The number of Bands 5 and 6 results is extremely encouraging. Even though there has been a slight decrease in the number overall from 2010, this year's results represent a continued focus on academic endeavour and a commitment to achieving the best.

The following information summarises the success of the 2011 HSC cohort:

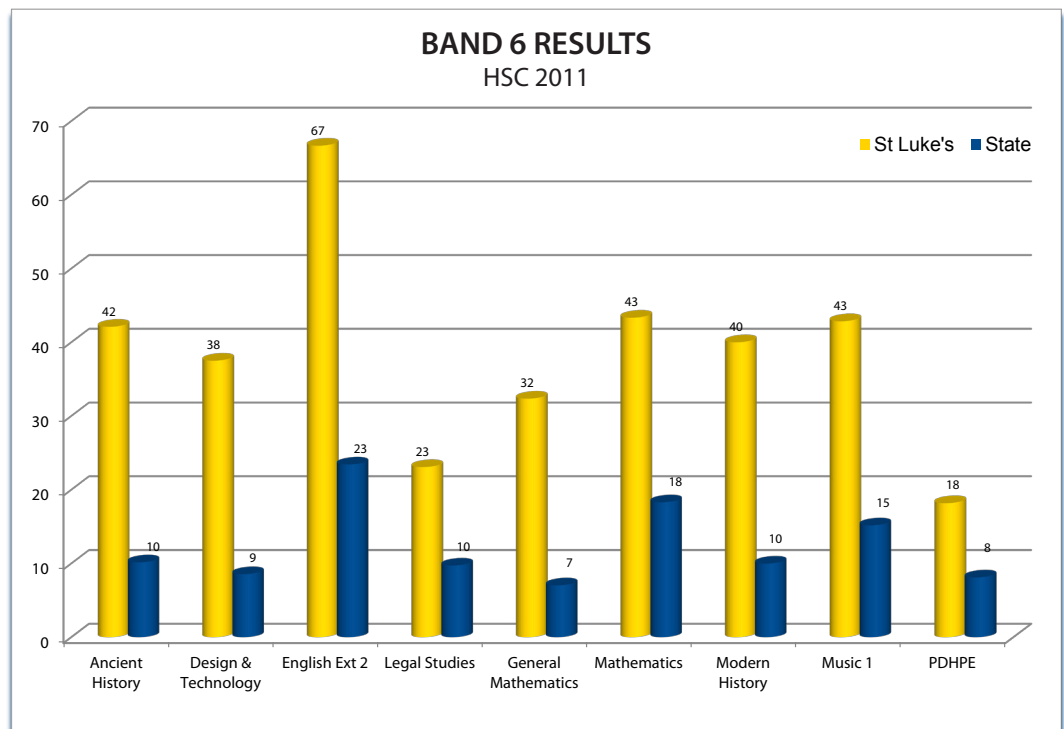
- 84 students sat for the HSC in 2011. 13 students from Year 11 sat for one or more HSC subjects.

- 42 (43 %) St Luke's students achieved 77 Band 6 [E4]s results
- 78 (80 %) St Luke's students achieved 218 Band 5 (E3) results
- 15% of all St Luke's students' results were Band 6
- 56 % of all St Luke's students' results were Band 5 or Band 6 (including accelerants) Top ATAR : 97.55 gained by Jonathan Eade

**Band 6 Results:** The number of Band 6 results gained across a broad spectrum of subjects is well above the State percentage of students gaining Band 6's in numerous subjects.

In a number of subjects St Luke's students achieved Band 6 results at almost or more than double that achieved by the State.

### Outstanding Individual Results

**All Rounder:** Sophie Mackenzie gained 90 or more in 10 units or more and was recognised on the All Rounders List. Daniel Barnett was 1 mark off this list.

**Top Achiever:** Sam Skinner placed 3rd in the State in General Mathematics with a mark of 99%.

### Outstanding Major Works

Brodie Delahunty's major work for Design Technology was nominated for DesignTECH.

Tim Morris' major work for Visual Arts was nominated for ArtEXPRESS

### Average Mark in Course

The average mark for most courses studied at St Luke's was above the average mark for the State. In particular, the average mark for each the following subjects were well above the State average.

### St Luke's Ranking
