Academic Scholarships

All registrations for Academic Scholarships are to be completed ONLINE.

1. St Luke's Grammar School awards Academic Scholarships to students in Years 7, 10 and 11.
2. All Academic Scholarships are available to both existing St Luke's students and those not currently enrolled.
3. The awarding of the Academic Scholarships will be based upon performance in the Academic Assessment Services testing as well as a review of the student's portfolio that they will be requested to upload at registration.
4. Based on the results of the tests as well as the review of the student's portfolio, a percentage of applicants will be called in for an Interview.
5. The student's portfolio should include the following:
 - NAPLAN Results
 - Recent School Reports
 - UNSW ICAS Certificate Awards, ie High Distinction in Mathematics, Distinction in Science etc
 - Summary of Extra Curricular Achievements in Music, Sport, Performing Arts or Drama
 - Other relevant information that gives insight into the applicant's interests and achievements
6. The Principal, in consultation with the Head of Senior School, will determine the Scholarship(s) to be offered.
7. The Academic Scholarships will be offered as either 100%, 50% or 25% of School Fees (Not including Acceptance Fees or Service Charges) depending upon the number of students identified for receiving a Scholarship.
8. All Academic Scholarship recipients will be placed in the Headland Program for Gifted and Talented students.
9. Academic Scholarship recipients will have their progress reviewed each year.

Approximately 10 days prior to the Scholarship Examination, the School will send a letter confirming registration and giving further details of the Examination day. In general, the important information about the day include:

- The examination concludes at 12:30 pm.
- Bottled water will be provided by the School and morning tea will need to be brought by the student.
