1. All-Rounder Scholarships are offered for entry into Years 10 and 11.
2. Applicants must be Australian citizens or permanent residents.
3. All-Rounder Scholarships are available only to students not already enrolled at St Luke's.
4. The awarding of the All-Rounder Scholarships will be based on the successful review of a Scholarship Portfolio and an interview with the Principal.
5. The student's portfolio should include the following:
  - a) Scholarship application [HERE](#)
  - b) Recent School Reports (two most recent)
  - c) NAPLAN Results (Year 7 and Year 9)
  - d) Demonstrated involvement in co-curricular activities (including Sport, Performing Arts, Community Service and Leadership)
6. Successful applicant(s) demonstrate:
  - a) An engagement in learning
  - b) Commitment to representing the School with integrity and alignment with the School's core values
  - c) Exemplary behaviour
  - d) Academic excellence
7. The Principal will determine the Scholarship(s) to be offered.
8. The All-Rounder Scholarship offers a remission of Tuition Fees (excluding Acceptance Fees and Service Charges) ranging from 25% to 100%. The scholarship remains in place until Year 12 and includes payment of associated co-curricular registration fees. To retain the scholarship, students must continue to demonstrate excellence in their chosen co-curricular field(s) while maintaining the expected academic standards.
9. Students who receive an All-Rounder Scholarship will be required to participate in school programs and events, represent the School as required when selected, provide leadership in activities related to their discipline and demonstrate all-round participation in school life through involvement in any other relevant co-curricular and leadership opportunities.
10. All-Rounder Scholarship recipients will have their progress reviewed annually. It is expected that the successful candidate will display acceptable levels of classroom behaviour and progress.

## SELECTION PROCESS

1. Applicants are required to apply online and upload supporting documentation, including a summary of achievements from the previous 3 years. This may include evidence of excellence and involvement in areas such as academic achievement, service, leadership, co-curricular activities, sport, competition results, representative selections and any relevant awards or recognition.
2. Relevant staff will review all applications, including their portfolio documentation.
3. Selected candidates will be interviewed by the Principal. Not all candidates who meet the criteria will proceed to interview. No feedback will be provided to unsuccessful candidates.
4. Scholarships are awarded at the School's absolute discretion.

## REVIEW AND RENEWAL

Scholarships are reviewed annually based on:

- Academic application throughout the year
- Co-curricular achievements and commitment
- Behaviour and character assessment
- Ongoing contribution to the School community

The Scholarship may be terminated if the student:

- Falls below satisfactory standards in relation to academic and behaviour expectations
- Engages in serious misconduct or behaviour detrimental to the School
- Does not meet their co-curricular commitments

Before termination, a written warning will be issued, and a meeting will be held with the parents/guardians and the student. The Principal ultimately determines the termination of a scholarship.

All applications and supporting documentation are to be submitted by **FRIDAY 28 AUGUST 2026**.
